Wireless LAN PC / PCI Card

This Quick Installation Guide is intended for users who are familiar with Wireless LAN PC / PCI Card driver installation for Windows 98/ME/2000/XP.

Installation for Windows 98/ME/2000/XP

During the installation, Windows may need to copy systems files from the Windows installation diskette or CD-ROM. Therefore you may need a copy of the Windows installation diskette or CD-ROM at hand before installing the drivers. On Win98/ME operating systems the necessary installation files are usually archived on the hard disk in the C:\WINDOWS\OPTIONS\CABS directory.

Note: Please upgrade the BIOS and System Drivers of your laptop to the latest version available. The Wireless LAN Card may not work properly with the following laptop models:

1. IBM-X31, Cardbus chipset Ricoh 5C476 (II)
2. Acer TravelMate 650/660/260, Cardbus chipset O2 Micro
3. Acer laptop, Cardbus chipset Ricoh 5C475(II)
4. HP-NX7000, Cardbus chipset ENE CB1410 Cardbus Controller

Run Setup from the Installation CD

1. Turn on the computer.
 2. Make sure that there isn't any Wireless LAN PC / PCI Card inserted.
 3. Insert the **Installation CD** into your CD-ROM drive. The setup program should start automatically. If it does not start automatically, you can run it manually by double clicking on the **setup.htm** file from CD-ROM drive.
 4. Select **Client** and then select **Drivers**. From the list displayed select the appropriate model number and then click on the **Open** button.
 5. The **Install Shield Wizard** will appear, click on the **Next** button. This will copy the files necessary for the installation process.
 6. The installation process is ready to begin, click on the **Next** button.
 7. Read the **Software License Agreement**, click on the **Yes** button. The installation process will then begin and copy the necessary files.
 8. Click on the **Finish** button to complete the first part of the installation process.
 9. Insert the PC / PCI card into the PCMCIA / PCI slot of your computer. Windows will then detect the device.
- CAUTION:** Gently insert the PC / PCI card into the slot. Forcing a misaligned card into the slot can damage the card and the computer.
10. Select **Install the software automatically (Recommended)** radio button and then click on the **Next** button. Windows will then begin to copy the necessary files.
 11. Click on the **Finish** button to complete the installation process.

Wireless LAN PC / PCI Card

Make sure that the network protocol parameters of your computer are set correctly. These include the IP address, subnet mask, gateway and DNS. If you aren't familiar with how to set the network protocol parameters, refer to the User's Manual in the Installation CD.

View the User's Manual

The User's Manual includes a more detailed version of the installation process along with details on how to configure the client utility. Follow the steps below in order to view the User's Manual.

1. Insert the **Installation CD** into your CD-ROM drive. The setup program should start automatically. If it does not start, you can run it manually by double clicking on the **setup.htm** file from CD-ROM drive.
2. Select **Client** and then select **User's Manual**. From the list displayed select the appropriate model number to view the User's Manual.

Note: You must have Adobe Acrobat Reader installed on your computer in order to view the User's Manual.

Install Adobe Acrobat Reader 6.0

1. Insert the **Installation CD** into your CD-ROM drive. The setup program should start automatically. If it does not start, you can run it manually by double clicking on the **setup.htm** file from CD-ROM drive.
2. Select **Client** and then select **User's Manual**. Click on the **Adobe Acrobat** hyperlink, and then click on the **Open** button.
3. Follow the steps in the Adobe Acrobat wizard to install the software.
